### Jesus, Friend of Sinners: But How?

Jesus was called a friend of sinners by the Pharisees ( Matthew 9:11; 11:16-19 ). They meant it as an assault on His reputation. The Pharisees, from their own sense of self-righteousness and superiority, kept their distance from "tax collectors and sinners" (a despised group), whereas Jesus conversed with and even dined with them ( Luke 19:5-7 ). The Pharisees were, of course, sinners as well ( Romans 3:23; Matthew 23:27-28 ), but they did not view themselves as such ( Luke 18:9-14 ).
