Position it so the wrong side -- the dull side -- of the fabric is facing up. This allows the right side to be showing once the pirate bandana is complete. Fold over the top corner -- the one facing away from you -- so the tip is near the center of the fabric. Smooth the fold with your fingers.

Fold the corner nearest you up to meet the furthest corner forming a triangle. 3 Take the points of the triangle on your left and right in both your hands. Fold the paper in half lengthwise. Fold the paper in half widthwise and crease it. Fold the top corners down so they form two triangles. Fold the rectangle's front flap up so the bottom edge of the paper meets the base of the triangles.
